**Police officer beaten at tribal burial grounds**

NORWICH, Conn. — A Mashantucket tribal police officer was attacked and beaten Wednesday night by a man at the tribe's burial grounds on Fanning Road in Ledyard. State police and officers from the Ledyard Police Department responded to the scene about 6:45 p.m. after tribal police told them they had lost contact with the officer after assistance was requested, according to a press release from state police.

Police described the attacker as being either Asian or Hispanic, about 5-feet, 7-inches tall, and wearing a hooded sweat-shirt and blue jeans.

The identify of the officer is being withheld pending further investigation.

**Crow Agency man gets prison in foiled toy-gun robbery**

BILLINGS, Mont. — A Crow Agency man who used a toy gun to rob the TeePee Service convenience store there will spend three years in federal prison. Senior U.S. District Judge Jack Shanstrom Wednesday sentenced Jeremiah Paul Stewart, 24, to a term slightly shorter than the guideline range, saying three years was

"fair and proper." Stewart's co-defendant and cousin, Joral Stewart, was sentenced earlier to one year in prison for being an accessory after the fact.

Stewart pleaded guilty in July to a robbery charge for the incident Aug. 30, 2006. Prosecutor Lori Suek said Stewart and his cousin were drinking that day and took a relative's car. Stewart wanted to rob the TeePee, and Joral

Stewart drove to the store. Tying an old shirt over his face and grabbing a toy gun that was in the car, Stewart entered the store and pointed the gun at the clerk while his cousin stayed in the car. The clerk wrestled with Stewart, who ran to the car and escaped with his cousin. Nothing was taken. The clerk identified Stewart, and DNA tests on the shirt confirmed the robber was Stewart.
