Soboba chairman, facing bribery charges, placed on leave by tribe

RIVERSIDE, Calif. — The Soboba Tribal Council placed its tribal chairman on leave Tuesday amid federal bribery charges.

"The Tribal Council of the Soboba Band of Luiseño Indians has placed Robert Salgado Sr. on administrative leave pending resolution of the allegations against him, during which time Mr. Salgado is not authorized to conduct business or represent the Tribe in any capacity," read a statement released Tuesday afternoon by the council.

Reached by phone, Salgado reaffirmed his position as chairman and said the administrative leave would not affect the tribe or the casino's general business.

"I'm still chairman. I'm just on leave," Salgado said. "I'll always be the

leader; the Creator put me in that position. They're just allegations and we'll see how the dust settles."

He said it was necessary to take leave so tribal business could continue and to not conflict with federal funding the tribe receives. Salgado has been elected tribal chairman off and on for more than 30 years. He said he does not receive any payment from the tribe as chairman.

Salgado was charged last month in a 36-count bribery indictment by the U.S. attorney's office. Federal prosecutors allege Salgado accepted \$250,000 in bribes to pay his personal debts in exchange for securing contracts for vendors to complete work at the casino. Federal officials have not charged any other members of the tribe or casino staff.

Salgado pleaded not guilty to the charges Monday in U.S. District Court in Los Angeles.
